Chicago Manual of Style is the citation style commonly used in business settings, it is written in **notes** or **author-date** format. Sources can be copied from bibliographies provided by IDL without need to re-format.

Attribution of Research Material

Endnote:

Each note corresponds to a number¹ in the text. Sources listed numerically in a separate bibliography.

Example: Content taken from resource.¹ Original content.

Bibliography entry for print-based source:

1. Contributor Name. "Title of Resource." *Publishing Organization*. Last edited date. (Page or section number)

Web-based source:

1. Contributor Name. "Page Title." Website Title. Web Address (Date Accessed).

Author-date:

Appears at the end of a section of content pulled from outside source, with Author's last name, publication date and page number in parenthesis. Sources listed alphabetically by last name in a separate bibliography.

Example: Content taken from resource. (Baker 2018, 25)

Bibliography entry for print-based source:

Able, J. "Title of Resource." *Publishing Organization*. Last edited date. (Page or section number)

Baker, D. "Title of Resource." *Publishing Organization*. Last edited date. (Page or section number)

Web-based source:

Last Name, First Name. "Page Title." Website Title. Web Address (Date Accessed).

Attribution of CID Contribution

Endnote bibliographic annotation:

Author-date annotation within document/presentation:

Content taken from resource. (UWCID, 2018)

Author-date bibliographic annotation:
